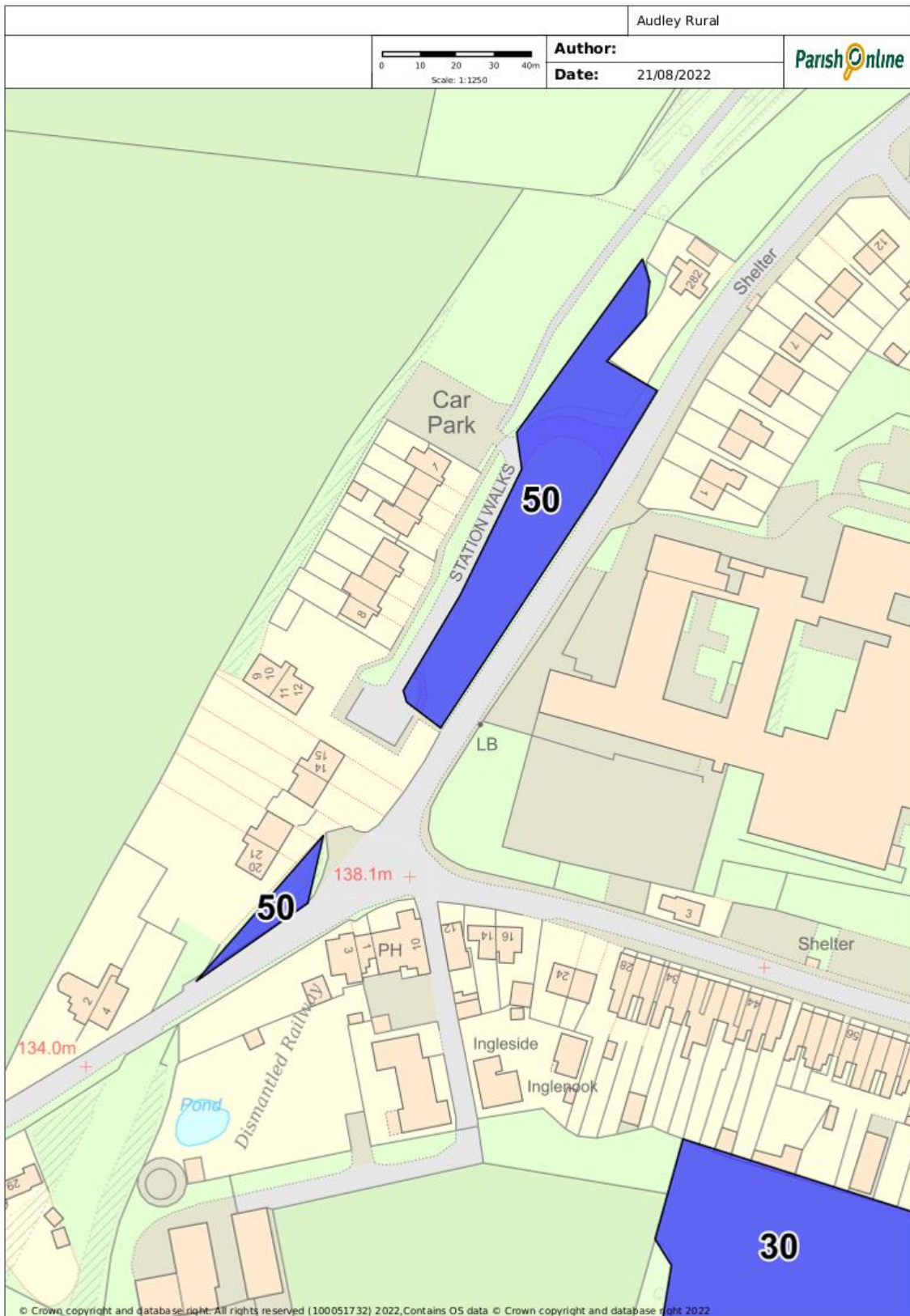


## Site 50– Station Walks Green Space, pit tub and planted areas
